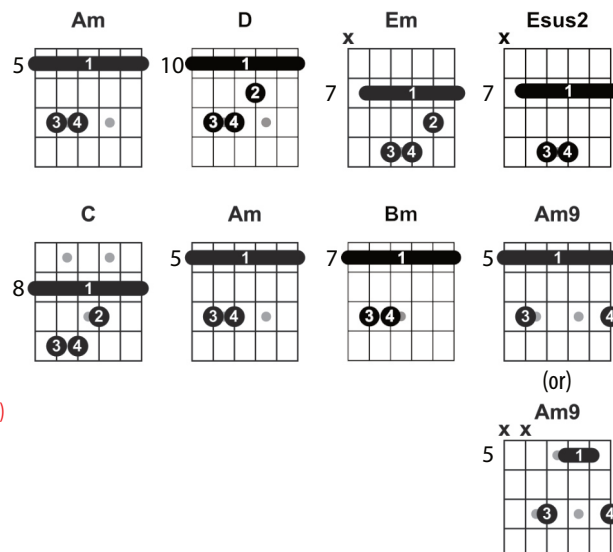
Talking about a girl that looks quite like you.
