

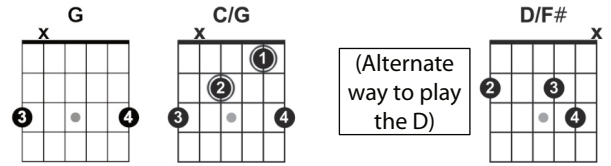
Key: D **Capo:** 7th Fret

Note 1: Better for my voice and easier chords to play as well has the C/G hammer on adds a lot.

Note 2: This sounds great when a second guitarist with the capo on the 7th fret, which is still in D, but has the G chords. See the other version.

Note 3: G – C/G = Mostly upstrokes.

Note 4: To play this in the original key of B, put the capo on the 4th fret.



Solo: D Major Form 1 on the 10th fret.
