And she takes you down to New Orleans and on out to the sea

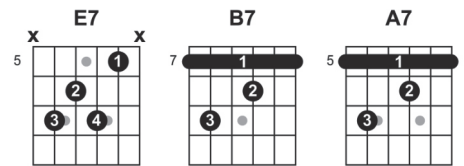
